- Language Arts - Reading & Writing 155 minutes
- Science 95 minutes
- Social Studies 75 minutes
- Mathematics 120 minutes

Exam Fee: \$36 per subject test payable to GED

- \$144 for full exam battery
- Pay as you test each module
- Receive two free retakes per module

\$10 per Retest (Proctoring Fee)

Total exam fee will be \$144

Test takers may take each subtest a maximum of three (3) times in a year.

There is a 60-day waiting period after the 2nd retake in a subtest.

Exam Fee: \$26 per subject test payable to HiSET

- Pay as you test each module
- Receive two free retakes per module

Total exam fee will be \$130 for Computer-Based and \$130 for Paper-Based

HiSET test takers may take each subtest a maximum of three (3) times in 6 months. The 6 month period is split into two 6 month periods each year.

First 6 month period: January 1 to June 30th.

Second 6 month period: July 1 to December 31st.
